1 National elections will be held soon to determine which political parties will be in government for the next four years. Pray that the Lord would appoint godly politicians committed to Judeo-Christian values.

2 There is an alarming trend that aims to give Muslims the right to work towards being an increasingly separate community. This could lead to parallel societies with tribal mentalities and make it more difficult to preach the Gospel in those areas.

3 Our five year ministry objective comes to an end this year. Pray for wisdom as we evaluate the past and seek the Lord to determine our future course of ministry. Pray for team as our Field Director is stepping down after 15 years of faithful service in order to focus on other areas of ministry.

4 Pastors of many churches we work with are in a 'maintenance' mode where mission all too easily loses its significance. Pray that ministry to Muslims would be pursued with a sense of urgency.

5 Pray for Mohammad and a number of promising leaders who came to Christ from Muslim backgrounds. Many of them face difficulties in keeping their jobs and following the Lord in all areas of their lives. Pray for victory in the face of temptation.

6 Pray for a young man who got death threats as a result of his commitment to Christ. He fled the country and his family faces great financial difficulties.

7 Pray for K., R. and B., new workers preparing to join the UK ministry. May they be able to raise the needed prayer and financial support to join us soon.

Guadeloupe



8 Pray for the formation of four churches in the next five years: The Saints Islands, Vieux Fort, Vernoux, Morne, and Rouge. Small groups are meeting already; appointing and training leadership is needed. Eddie, Albert, and Joseph are the pastors who are involved.

9 Frequent strikes disrupt daily life and cause untold hardship for people. Pray for peace in Guadeloupe.

10 Praise God for those who have shown initiative in starting ministries for specific groups: high school and college students, abused women, the unemployed. One group of government employees and social workers created a counseling service to help people work through bureaucracy while holding out the hope of the Gospel.

11 A new President of the national church was elected in January. Pray for him as he sets the course for the whole church. Pray that he would have a vision for empowering others and multiplying leaders.

12 Pray for MKs who are in university or recently graduated and looking for work while living far from family. Justin and Caleb, sons of Duane and Joetta Moyer, are in the US. Pray for daughter Amanda Moyer (age 12) who is currently the only MK in Guadeloupe. She misses English-speaking friendships.

13 Pray that grace might overcome the natural tendency to turn to a rule-based Gospel. Pray for those launching new initiatives to weather the inevitable criticism: "We've never done it that way before."

14 Pray for older leaders who are passing the baton to a new generation. Pray that young leaders will be gracious and appreciate those who have gone before.

15 Mobilization: Pray for the mission-wide initiative to mobilize workers. Pray for the Mobilization teams of each sending office as they help people discover God's purpose for them among the nations.

16 Communications: Pray for creativity and wisdom in sharing stories of God's work around the world with ministry partners and supporters. Pray for good internal communication throughout the mission.

17 Information Technology: Pray for Bob as he builds a strategy for global communications. Pray for good decision-making, realistic expectations, and good relationships. Pray against discouragement.

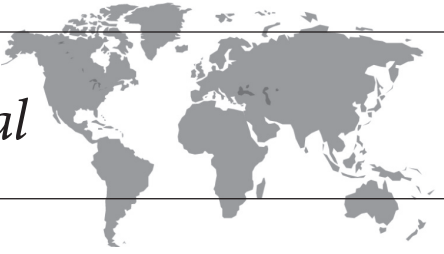
18 Development: Pray for integrity, wisdom and transparency in everything as they raise funds vital to World Team's ongoing needs and expansion of ministries.

26 Pray for the ministry in Cuba and especially for the families of pastors. They are faced with many social pressures and great financial stress. Pray for the Lord's help in these crucial areas of life and for His blessing upon their ministry.

27 Remember International Director David Riddell and his wife Rebecca. Pray that the Lord would guide and direct their steps as they

serve the mission and keep them safe as they travel.

28 Please pray for the mobilization efforts from each field. Pray that the Lord would bless our efforts and show us innovative ways to expand the mission and God's Kingdom.
