1 Edwin & Amy Samson arrived in the Philippines last month to begin their first term. Praise God! Pray for them as they begin to settle in, learn language and establish relationships.

2 Many missionary kids call the Philippines home. For Junia, age 12, last year was the best of her life because God used Faith Academy to draw her closer to Himself. She adapted Bible study materials and is reaching out to friends. Pray for non-believing Filipino kids to join her Saturday Bible study.

3 The *Jonathan Project* is a two-week seminar for pastors, lay leaders and missionaries to plan and apply church multiplication principles. Held 11 times since 2001, 218 people working among 28 different people groups have participated. Bob French helped train participants in the session last fall. Pray for good fruit and unity to grow out of these sessions.

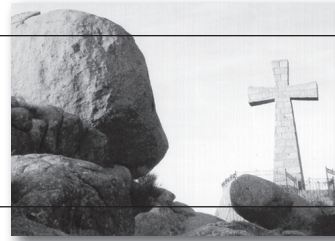
4 Help is needed on our team. Pray for a business manager (20 hours per week), church planters for rural areas, and teachers at Faith Academy.

5 Pray for Sydney Darling as she prepares for a 1-year apprenticeship to begin June 2010. Pray for her spiritual preparation and for needed funds.

6 Pray for workers living in remote areas. Communication can be difficult and unreliable.

7 Pray for the ministry in Catanduanes, especially for those exploring the Bible for the first time. One couple decided to throw away their house idol after reading the Bible! Pray for deep spiritual growth and peace in Christ for new believers.

8 Pray for Spain Team as we seek to develop a 'Gospel centered' training tool for widespread use in the churches in Spain.

9 Pray for God's leading regarding potential pioneer church planting sites: Vision Norte (Madrid), Arroyo de la Luz (Caceres), Guijuelo (Bejar).

10 Pray for continued readjustment for the Ginter family returning to Spain after being in Canada.

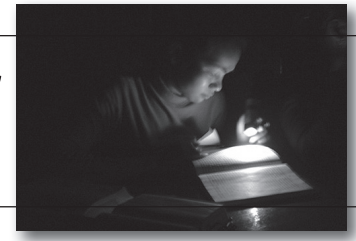
11 Pray for good team dynamics among elders of El Puente church. Seve officially joins the team and will serve alongside Fernando and Tim Tjernagel.

12 Pray for those still seeking to raise prayer and financial support to join Spain Team: Doug & Amy Nunziato, Mike & Daniela Riley, and Kristin Bond. Kristin starts her apprenticeship in May/June 2010.

13 Pray for those participating in the Spain Prayer Conference May 29--June 5, 2010. May the Lord use their prayers to open doors for new ministry and break spiritual strongholds! Pray for our Spanish friends and partners to be encouraged.

14 Pray for our team members, that we would use our gifts for the advancement of the kingdom, and that we would live out of the Gospel more and more each day.

Persecuted Church



15 At least seven people were killed in the town of Nag Hamadi in Egypt on January 6 when gunmen opened fire on churchgoers exiting a Christmas Eve service. Christian Copts in Egypt observe Christmas on January 7.

16 Continue to pray for Christians in North Korea as Kim Jong-il introduces a new constitution that further bolsters the role of the armed forces.

17 Pray for the pastor and congregation of Boukham Church in Laos. The pastor was kidnapped, detained, interrogated, and terrorized for five to six hours on September 3rd. Authorities demanded he renounced his Christianity or face deportation.

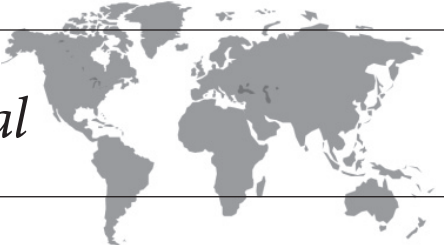
18 Let us keep in fervent prayer the vulnerable church in Mauritania, West Africa. Pray for unity and a solid foundation for the church and that many more will find the truth in Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

19 Churches in Myanmar lack the resources to build meeting places. They also struggle to secure government permits to begin construction. Pray for God's favor as they apply for building permits.

20 Known terrorist groups threaten Christians with death or expulsion in Nepal. Pray for courage and faith in the face of those seeking to harm them.

21 Chechen Christians live under difficult circumstances with little fellowship with one another. Pray for their needs to be met and for Christ to be their comfort and joy in all things.

Global



22 Haiti: Recovery efforts are ongoing following the January 12 earthquake. We're grateful to all who gave toward the Haiti Recovery Project. Pray for those grieving the loss of loved ones. Pray for those helping to rebuild and provide comfort to the suffering.

23 Cuba: The Los Pinos Nuevos Seminary continues to prepare pastors, leaders and all who serve in their churches. They have a special emphasis on preparing church planters.

24 Italy: Pray for God to work in people's lives through our Friday night study and our Sunday afternoon women's study.

25 Jamaica: Pray for Duane Moyer and Susan Best as they work on a new partnership to encourage inner city believers to explore missions and to train and equip Jamaicans for cross-cultural service.

26 Global Mobilization: Pray with us that we would see an annual increase of five to seven percent in the number of new World Team cross-cultural workers in the next three years.

27 Mobilization Teams: Pray for the Mobilization teams at the Sending Centers in Australia, Canada, and the United States. Pray for wisdom and grace as they disciple those interested in cross-cultural ministry.

28 NYC: Please pray for healthy new house churches to be started among international students.

29 Central Asia: Pray that the Lord would provide all of the resources and means necessary to bring the Gospel to the Hui people (money, food, water, godly laborers with various skills, etc.).

30 Leadership: Lift up in prayer mission leaders and leaders among our national partners and their churches. Pray for a growing reliance upon Jesus and spiritual wisdom as they lead others.

31 Remember International Director David Riddell and his wife Rebecca. Pray that the Lord would guide and direct their steps as they serve the mission.
