

East Asia



1 Praise God for new workers! Pray for their transition to life and ministry in a new country: family K arrived in June; CM arriving in September; family W arriving in October; and family T who are tentatively scheduled for some time later this year.

2 Some workers live in places that have experienced civil unrest this year. Pray for safety in the midst of continued instability and for peace to be established. It is hard to get work done for their businesses in the current environment.

3 Pray for the peace of Christ to reign in the heart of each worker. Isolation and unexpected changes add to the daily challenges of life and ministry. Pray for spiritual maturity as they abide in Christ.

4 Give thanks for a good spring semester for the English teaching business. Pray for 50 new students for next semester.

5 Pray for D & C in their efforts to mobilize workers, specifically experienced business people. Give thanks for good networking opportunities. Pray for good fruit to come from the seeds sown.

6 Pray for wisdom as new business plans are made and others are evaluated. Ask the Lord to give guidance regarding the best structure, strategy and people to integrate business and mission.

7 Workers face many spiritual strongholds that can only be overcome by God's mighty hand. Pray for the spiritual discipline to fast and pray. Ask the Spirit to grant perseverance and peace, even when they don't see 'results'.

New York City



8 Thank the Lord for six interns who spent the summer participating in the NYC ministry. Pray for God's leading in their lives as they consider future ministry possibilities. Pray for the NYC team as they follow up on connections made by the interns.

9 J was a visiting professor from China who studied the Bible for 6 months with the NYC team. He was baptized on Christmas day and has since returned to China. In his testimony he shared that "God's work is the number one thing. I should work for God's Kingdom instead of my own interest." Pray for J, he hopes to begin a house church in China.

10 Pray for upcoming events as the new semester begins, including English clubs and Bible studies. Ask the Lord to draw those who are open spiritually. Pray for more workers to join us.

11 Pray for L and H who study the Bible with us. Both are deeply struck by the idea of sin and separation from God. Pray for their grasp of the Gospel.

12 Pray for those who are studying God's Word in earnest, but fear being baptized. This is a big step for many and some equate it with saying 'no' to their families.

13 Pray for LY and M. They are both resistant to learning more about God and have turned instead to meditation practices.

14 Pray for the NYC team to guard their hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Pray for wisdom in managing their time in light of so many opportunities.

15 Pray for our Australia, Canada and US Sending Country Directors in their leadership of the teams that support World Team missionaries.

16 Pray for Paul and Stephanie Muzzin serving with WT Canada as they raise support for the media ministry.

17 Pray for Mobilizers as they interact with potential missionary candidates. Pray with us for more short- and long-term workers.

18 Pray for God's provision of financial needs for overall ministry and specific field projects.

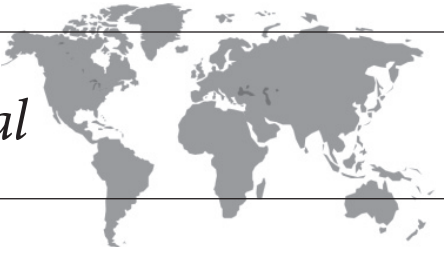
19 Lift up in prayer WT Australia Director Brian Billing as he continues recovering from surgery. Many others are facing serious health problems right now and in need of prayer.

20 Praise the Lord for the ChurchLink team and the handful of partnership agreements signed this year with churches committed to sending church-based teams. Pray for each church as the teams are formed and decisions are made as to where to send them.

21 Pray for the Member Care team as they support and encourage our missionary families, especially those going through transitions.

22 Pray for good relationships with national partners. Language and culture present unique challenges to relationships. Pray for a unity of spirit that would transcend our differences.

23 Pray for intentional, healthy mentoring and leadership development among our missionaries and within the churches related to our ministry.

24 Ask the Lord to refresh the work of our hands and for the Holy Spirit to grant patience, wisdom and humility as we serve.

25 Thank the Lord for His sustaining grace in our lives and our collective ministry. Pray for a greater understanding of how we are all interdependent and therefore should not be jealous, envious or self-seeking.

26 Remember in prayer those are heavy-hearted and weary. Pray for the comfort of the Holy Spirit to renew their strength.

27 Give thanks for the love and labor of our retired missionaries. Many continue their ministry through prayer and encouraging others to consider missions. Pray for those who have picked up the baton from them and are laboring now to see Christ glorified among the unreached. May we have wisdom to learn from those who have gone before us even as we press on toward what lies ahead.

28 Pray for the children who learn about Jesus through the vacation Bible Schools, Sunday schools and other activities in WT-related churches around the world. May they know Christ at a young age and become agents of change in their generation. Pray that we would recognize and encourage future missionaries in our midst!

29 Pray for those who use business skills, teaching or medicine to meet physical needs in the places we serve. Thank God for their gifts and pray His blessing upon their ministry.

30 Pray for the leading of the Holy Spirit as decisions are made about new ministry opportunities and how to draw others to a close well.

31 Pray for the men and women who are considering candidate orientation (RACE) in October. Ask the Lord to remove any barriers to their coming and to prepare their hearts for what they will learn about themselves and global missions.
