1 Bill Stothers is one of 12 Chaplains who lead weekly evangelistic Chapel services for 28 Major League Baseball academies in the Dominican Republic. Chapels often turn into hour long Bible studies. Pray for effective discipleship of new, young believers.

2 Pray for more Chaplains to help reach the players, coaches and staff for Christ. Pray especially for Emmanuel, Bill's "Timothy" in the ministry, who also works full-time to reach ball players for Christ.

3 Praise God for 78 players who received Christ this year. Pray for their witness among other players in the league.

4 Give thanks for a larger meeting place for the Santiago church. Pray for needed funds to help them finish the first phase of the building.

5 Priscilla Stothers is thankful for open doors to run weekly Mom-to-Mom support groups and to train Community Peer Counselors in needy communities.

6 The National Public Health Department and UNICEF have contracted Priscilla's team to reach even more communities by training Peer Counselor Trainers in three main cities. Pray that these teams would be a light for Christ in the cities where they serve.

7 Give thanks for the children who came to Christ and others who grew in their faith at Kid's Camp this year. Two young adults who are former campers are now taking on the leadership of Kid's Camp and doing an amazing job. Pray for their continued growth as disciples of Christ and leaders of this dynamic ministry.

8 One of WT Australia's partner local churches is launching a new English as a Second Language class. The church is surrounded by international people of all ages. Pray for the nervous volunteers. Ask God to bring students with hearts ready to hear the Gospel and respond.

9 Pray for God to blow open the doors for substantial ministry among Chinese international students of Swinburne University in Melbourne. Students are often busy. Pray for opportunities to build meaningful relationships.

10 John and Sharon Pirrotta completed their ministry as church planters in Redland Bay and will now serve as hostel parents at Willara House. Pray for them in this time of transition.

11 Pray for Jim Sterrey, Lyn Hollingworth and several volunteers who help maintain the WT Australia office.

12 Jessie Williams continues to progress through medical treatment for leukemia. Pray that Jessie will know God's special presence during this difficult time of treatment.

13 Pray for Brian Billing as he leads WT Australia. Pray for mobilization of more workers from Australia to the least-reached parts of the world.

14 Pray for Andrew and Donna Williams. They have major decisions to make about their future in light of Andrew's health concerns and not being able to return to ministry in Papua at this time.

15 Thank God for the dedication of volunteer engineers who help keep Radio Lumiere in Haiti up and running. Pray for them and for the vital ministry of Radio Lumiere.

16 Mercy Medical Center is a multi-organizational medical center in Cambodia providing excellent health care and training. Ask God for provision of funds still needed for the building campaign. Give thanks for lives being healed physically and spiritually.

17 WT Philippines has a partnership with the Commonwealth churches to see Filipino church planters trained and sent cross-culturally. The vision is to spark church planting movements.

18 A new ministry effort in Jamaica is providing ministry training and experience for African Americans preparing for future ministries among unreached peoples.

19 Partnership in Africa is taking place on many levels - among agencies, national churches, translation committees, etc. Pray for the body of Christ in Africa to work in unison and result in more fruitfulness than could be accomplished independently.

20 In Suriname, house churches in one city are spreading through the cooperative efforts of missionaries and pastors from around the world.

21 Praise God for World Team's partnership with the many local churches who send and support our missionaries.
