

Taiwan



1 World Team and OMF missionaries in Taiwan work in partnership to reach the working class. Only 0.5 percent are Christians despite being the majority of Taiwan's population (60–70 percent of 23 million people). Pray for more workers—including upper class Taiwanese churches—to join them in reaching the working class.

2 Taiwan's Presidential election will be held this month. Pray for fair elections and good leadership.

3 Taiwan has the most temples per capita per square mile in the world. It's a modern country with a strong folk religion. Pray for God's truth to shine brightly here.

4 Pray for Taiwanese believers to be courageous in their stand against the worship of idols, ancestors and spirits.

5 Chiayi City Team: Pray for team unity among the diverse group of workers and for the Chens as they lead the team. Pray for opportunities to build relationships with the many young families in their area. They make contacts through time spent with their kids in the park on Sundays.

6 Taiping Team: The team opened a prayer center in the heart of Taiping and have focused on outreach events, mom's groups and hospital visitation. Pray for good relationships for sharing the gospel. Pray for workers, some of whom are experiencing big changes or having trouble with culture shock.

7 Pray for the children on the Taiwan team as they consider what they can do for God in Taiwan. Pray for their spiritual growth and for their witness to friends.

10 Pray for a spiritual breakthrough in the Sanfernando area. Ask God's blessing upon the radio ministry, that it would touch many hearts.

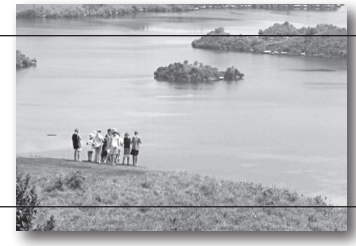
11 Retired missionary Edith Johnson gives thanks for protection during a car accident several months ago. Please pray for her Bible studies and those who participate with her.

17 Naomi Anderton gives thanks for her roommates and a job on campus. She asks for prayer for good time management to balance studies, rest and relationships.

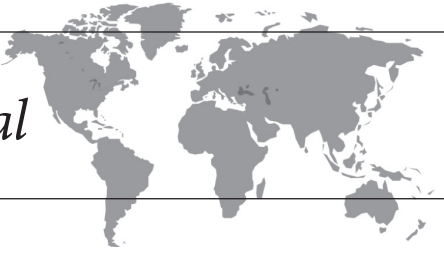

24 Pray for workers who are battling serious illness at this time. Lift up those who are discouraged or weary. Bring them before the throne of grace and mercy.

25 Give thanks, God is doing marvelous things in Cuba. People are coming to Christ, Christians are growing in their faith and being trained, and there are new avenues for outreach.

26 The team in Milan, Italy asks for prayer in identifying at least two Italians to work more closely with them. Pray also for training of the women in one of their partner churches, that the women would be strengthened in their faith and witness. Ron & Amy Smith have a burden to develop a marriage study for their Italian friends.

27 Rejoice with the team in Suriname. Marco & Marjolein Schuurman arrived in November and have begun language and culture study for ministry among the Wayanas.

28 World Team International leaders, Sending Country Directors and Area Directors meet in Paris from January 28–February 3. Pray for clear discernment of God’s leading as they seek His face together. Pray for unity, vision and courageous leadership. Intercede for their families while they are apart.

29 Pray for efforts in the Philippines, Hong Kong, Papua and elsewhere to send missionaries to other parts of the world.

30 Beth Newton reminds us to pray for the nurse practitioner students who are working hard on their “memoires”, a Haitian mini-master’s thesis. God is able to lead them through the challenges to bring them to licensing with the ministries of health and education.
